DATA PROTECTION DECLARATION

The protection and security of your personal data is of particular concern to us. We undertake to comply with the statutory data protection provisions when operating our website, in particular in accordance with the European General Data Protection Regulation. As a matter of principle, we do not make your data available to third parties for use unless you have given your consent, this is permitted by law or we are obliged to disclose this data due to official or court orders.

As a rule, it is possible to access our website without providing personal data. Insofar as personal data (e.g. name, address or e-mail addresses) is collected on our website, this is always done on a voluntary basis as far as possible.

We would like to point out that data transmission on the Internet (e.g. when communicating by e-mail) can have security gaps. Complete protection of data against access by third parties is not possible.

ACCESS DATA

We do not collect, store, process or use any personal data from you in connection with simply accessing our website. However, data is collected that is temporarily stored in a log file on our server for the purpose of data security (server log files) and may allow identification (e.g. name of the file accessed, date and time of access, volume of data transferred, notification of successful access, browser type and version, the user's operating system, referrer URL and the requesting provider). This usage data is evaluated anonymously for statistical purposes by means of internal investigations with regard to user interests and user behaviour.

An evaluation of this usage data for the creation of personal usage profiles does not take place unless you have expressly consented to such use. We expressly reserve the right to analyse this data in the event of misuse of our website or other legal violations that could lead to a report being filed with the law enforcement authorities. Your usage data will not be evaluated beyond this or passed on to third parties.

COOKIES

Our website uses cookies. A cookie is a text file that is sent when visiting a website and is temporarily stored on the website user's hard drive. If the corresponding server of our website is called up again by the user of the website, the browser of the user of the website sends the previously received cookie back to the server. The server can then evaluate the information obtained through this procedure in various ways. Cookies can be used, for example, to control the display of advertisements or to facilitate navigation on a website. If the user wishes to prevent the use of cookies, he or she can do so by making local changes to his or her settings in the Internet browser used on his or her computer, i.e. the programme used to open and display Internet pages (e.g. Google Chrome, Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox, Opera or Safari).

Types of cookies

This website uses the following types of cookies:

- Technical cookies: these cookies are for the proper functioning of our website.
- Analytical cookies: These cookies are used to analyse the use of our website anonymously. For example, these cookies allow us to see whether the same user revisits our website at different times. They can also be used to improve the performance and usability of our website.

The majority of the cookies we use (session cookies) become invalid at the end of the browser session. Permanent cookies remain on your terminal device and enable us to recognise your browser on your next visit. This data is not used to personally identify the visitor to this website.



Cookies are stored on the user's computer and transmitted to our site by the user. Therefore, you as a user also have full control over the use of cookies. By changing the settings in your internet browser, you can disable or restrict the transmission of cookies.

Google Analytics:

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", which are text files placed on your computer, to help the website analyse how users use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of this website is usually transmitted to a Google server in the USA and stored there. In the event that IP anonymisation is activated on this website, however, your IP address will be truncated beforehand by Google within member states of the European Union or in other contracting states to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases will the full IP address be transmitted to a Google server in the USA and shortened there. On behalf of the operator of this website, Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage to the website operator. The IP address transmitted by your browser as part of Google Analytics will not be merged with other Google data. PURPOSE OF USE OF PERSONAL DATA AND LEGAL BASIS

Scope

As a matter of principle, we collect and use personal data of our users only insofar as this is necessary for the provision of a functional website as well as our contents and services. The collection and use of our users' personal data regularly takes place only with the user's consent.

An exception applies in those cases where obtaining prior consent is not possible for actual reasons and the processing of the data is permitted by legal regulations.

Purpose:

Personal data is only collected by us if and to the extent that you yourself provide it to us with your knowledge. The personal data you provide will be stored for the purpose of contacting you if you have expressly given us your consent to do so. You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. A statement of the processing purposes is made at the appropriate places on our websites and is not subject to subsequent change.

Data will only be passed on to third parties without your consent if we are legally obliged to do so. Legal basis:

Insofar as we obtain the consent of the data subject, Article 6 DSGVO serves as the legal basis for the processing of personal data. Likewise, Article 6 DSGVO is relevant for the processing of personal data that is necessary for the performance of a contract; a legal obligation to which our company is subject; for the performance of pre-contractual measures; in the event that vital interests of the data subject or a third party make processing necessary; or for the protection of a legitimate interest of our company or a third party and whose interests override the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject.

STORAGE PERIOD OF PERSONAL DATA

Personal data is stored for the duration of the respective statutory retention period. After expiry of the period, the data is routinely deleted unless it is necessary for the initiation or fulfilment of a contract. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS



Confirmation:

You have the right to request confirmation from us as to whether personal data is being processed. Information:

You have the right to obtain information about the data stored about you at any time, including the origin and recipients of your data and the purpose of the data processing.

We will provide you with the following information as a free copy:

Processing purposes

Categories of personal data processed

recipients or categories of recipients

planned storage period of the personal data or criteria for determining it

Existence of a right to rectification/deletion/

restriction/objection in connection with the processing of your personal data as well as the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority.

If the personal data is not collected from you: any available data on the origin of the data.

The existence of automated decision-making including profiling pursuant to Art. 22 (1), (4) DSGVO.

Correction:

You have a right to rectification and/or completion if the personal data processed concerning you is inaccurate or incomplete.

Erasure and oblivion:

You have the right to erasure of your personal data in accordance with the guidelines set out in Article 17 of the GDPR. Please click HERE to proceed with the erasure.

Procedure:

- 1) Download form to delete your personal data.
- 2) Fill in and sign the form.
- 3) Hand in signed document to the Plasma Centre at the registration desk.

Restriction:

You have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data. The requirements are derived from Art. 18 DSGVO.

Objection:

You have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data (collected on the basis of Art. 6(1)(e) or (f)). This also applies to profiling protected by these provisions. In the event of an objection, the data will not be further processed unless there are compelling legitimate and demonstrable grounds which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject, or for the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims.

Revocation of consent under data protection law:

Furthermore, you have the right to revoke your consent to the processing of personal data at any time. Data portability:

You have the right to receive your personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format.

You also have the right to transfer this data to third parties. Furthermore, in accordance with Art. 20 (1) DSGVO, you have the right to have your personal data transferred directly from us to another controller, insofar as this is technically possible and the rights and freedoms of other persons are not affected. If you wish to exercise your rights, please contact us/our data protection officer.

NOTICE OF DATA SHARING WITH OTHER WEBSITES

Facebook:
